Course of Study

This is a 3-year (six semesters) program with each semester 16 weeks long. Students may enter at the beginning of any semester and rotate through the program. The main course of study requires the completion of 96 lessons in Old Testament, New Testament and Bible Doctrine. Additional courses will be offered on a year to year basis.

Course Descriptions

Old Testament

Ninety-six lessons which survey the Old Testament chronologically from Genesis to Malachi.

New Testament

Ninety-six lessons which survey the entire New Testament.

Bible Doctrine

Ninety-six lessons which cover the main doctrines of Scripture.

Diploma/Certificate

Diploma of Biblical Studies—students must complete the 3 courses (six semesters), pass the take-home exams and read the Bible through once.

Certificate of Completion—students must attend the classes.
